Non-Saturday testing is available for students who cannot test on Saturday for religious reasons.

### RECENT CHANGES

ACT began digital testing at national test dates with a pilot study in December 2023, and they will continue to increase digital testing capacity throughout 2024. The test content and format will not otherwise change. International ACTs are administered on computers.

Students who take the ACT with standard timing will receive a 20-minute unscored experimental section following the Science Test and preceding the Writing Test.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The ACT takes approximately three hours and 30 minutes to complete, including breaks (or just over four hours with the Writing Test).
