GMAT OFFICIAL TESTS

THE GMAT IS AVAILABLE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

The GMAT is available as both an in-person computer test and a remotely proctored online test. The GMAT Online has the same content and structure as the in-person GMAT.

GMAT administrations should be scheduled once a student is fully prepared to take the test.

Students should check with the schools to which they are applying and then schedule an appointment early enough to allow scores to be reported before application deadlines.

RECENT CHANGES

The fourth quarter of 2023, GMAC will introduce a new GMAT: the GMAT Focus Edition. The current GMAT will be available until early 2024.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The GMAT takes just over three hours to complete, not including breaks. The GMAT Focus Edition will take two hours and 15 minutes.

The GMAT may be taken once every 16 calendar days, no more than five times within any rolling 12-month period, and no more than eight times in a lifetime.

GMAT scores are valid for five years.

CANCELLATIONS

GMAT Online scores cannot be canceled. Students are able to cancel scores within 72 hours of their completion of the official in-person GMAT for a \$25 fee.

Scores from in-person tests can be reinstated from the prior four years and 11 months for a \$50 fee.

Canceled scores can be reinstated up to four years and 11 months of the in-person exam date. Note that it can take up to 20 days for the reinstatement to be processed.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Disability Services may take approximately three to four weeks to process applications for testing accommodations. Students must apply for and receive an accommodation decision before scheduling a test date. Once approved, students will receive a letter stating the expiration of their appointed accommodations.
