

GRE OFFICIAL TESTS

2022–2023

THE GRE IS AVAILABLE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

The GRE is available as both an in-person computer test and a remotely proctored online test. The remotely proctored GRE has the same content and structure as the in-person GRE.

GRE administrations should be scheduled once a student is fully prepared to take the test.

Students should check with the schools to which they are applying and then schedule an appointment early enough to allow scores to be reported before application deadlines.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The computer GRE takes approximately four hours to complete, including breaks.

The GRE may be taken once every 21 days and no more than five times within any rolling 12-month period.

GRE scores are valid for five years after the testing year in which a student has tested (July 1–June 30).

If you want to reinstate canceled scores, you must do so within 60 days of your test date.
