The LSAT consists of four multiple choice sections, which appear in any order:

- **Arguments** (24–26 graded multiple choice questions)
- **Reading Comprehension** (26–28 graded multiple choice questions)
- **Logic Games** (22–24 graded multiple choice questions)
- **Experimental** (22–28 ungraded multiple choice questions)

The LSAT will be administered as a remotely proctored exam until at least June 2023.
